Advanced Sports Medicine

Sports medicine is not offered as an independent medical specialization in many countries, which is why the University of Continuing Education Krems has set itself the goal of establishing an innovative interdisciplinary Master's degree program in this field. The aim is to offer physicians specialized further training across the entire spectrum of sports medicine expertise. The high variety of specialized diagnostics and treatment in the filed of sports medicine may make it impossible for ambitious therapists to achieve a high level of education without a specific structured course system.

Study programme

The 'Advanced Sports Medicine, MSc (CE)' program covers the broad spectrum of prevention and diagnostics of sports injuries and sports related over use damage as well as the therapeutic, preventative and rehabilitative strategies in sport. The sports medicine knowledge of numerous internationally leading medical specialists and disciplines is incorporated into the course. The distribution across various locations (Krems, Leipzig, Straubing, Luxembourg, Basel) emphasizes the international highest level character of the program.

The program focusses intensively on interaction between spezialists and study participants as well as clinically relevant practical strategies. A research study in the form of a scientific article or master thesis is completed within the 3 semesters.

Admission requirements

Prerequisites for admission to the continuing education study program are

- > a university degree from a regular Austrian or equivalent foreign degree programme in human medicine at least at NQF level VII (e.g. Master's or Diploma)
- > and adequate clinical experience
